



## PHUKET SANDBOX TRAVEL ITINERARY

Dear Traveler,

To help you get a better idea of how may traveling within the 'New Normal' rules and regulations be like, we have prepared this sample itinerary.

Visitors must be fully vaccinated by the same and approved vaccine not less than 14 days before arrival. And have a negative PCR test not more than 72 hours prior to travelling. Travelers should come from low or medium risk zones and can fly directly to Phuket or via sealed airport route connecting in Bangkok.

All travelers must download ThailandPlus app, which uses GPS and Bluetooth to notify the user if they have been in close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case. Complimentary SIM cards will be provided on arrival at the airport in Phuket.

Day 1: 1<sup>st</sup> RT-PCR test on arrival at the airport.  
Transfer to SHA+ hotel by designated SHA+ transportation.

Day 2-5: After receiving negative results from the test, the guest can enjoy traveling on leisure anywhere within Phuket, visiting its many cultural sights and landmarks, savoring various foods, and relaxing on the beach.

Day 6: 2<sup>nd</sup> RT-PCR test at the nearest COVID-19 facility  
(there are 5 dedicated locations around Phuket for ease of access).

Day 7: After receiving negative results, visitors can continue to enjoy traveling around Phuket. But will also have an option to move to another SHA+ hotel of choice, or to Koh Samui and begin an enveloping wellness journey at Kamalaya (all hotels must be booked prior to arrival in Thailand).

Note: To travel around the country, both negative test results should always be carried to be presented at the travel check points.
